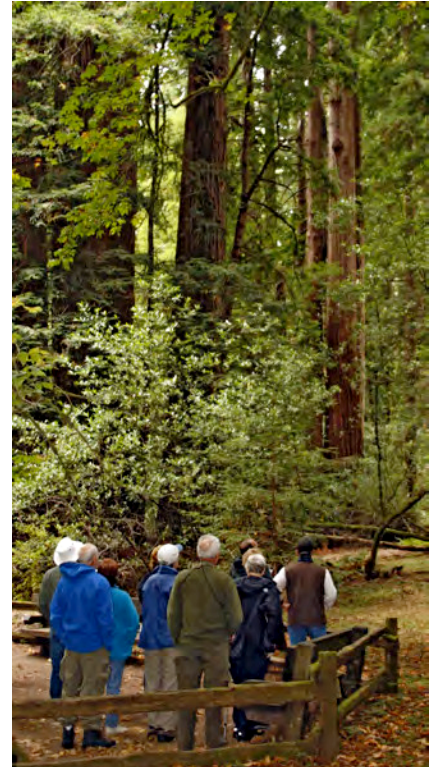

This **GRAND CALIFORNIA TRIP LIST** is the most up-to-date, complete list of birds accepted by the California Bird Records Committee (CBRC, http://www.wfo-cbrc.org/cbrc/ca_list.html). It follows the American Ornithologists Union's (AOU's) most current (1998, 7th edition) nomenclature changes, taxonomic order, and any recent splitting or lumping.

Those species whose names are preceded by an asterisk are of special interest to the CBRC, <http://www.wfo-cbrc.org/cbrc/review.html>. They range from a single record to less than an average of five records per year. Please document any sightings of these species with a photograph and/or a written description and send it/them to the current CBRC secretary: Guy McCaskie, CBRC Secretary, by e-mail at quymcc@pacbell.net or P.O. Box 275, Imperial Beach, CA 91933-0275.

Brackets enclose races that may receive species status by the AOU or comments of recent changes in lumping, splitting, or phylogenetic placement. Introduced species have an (I) and extirpated species have an (E) following their names. Yellow-billed Magpie is the only true California endemic species and hence is our cover bird.

Since many participants would like to know their chances of seeing particular species, **Column I** has numbers indicating how many of my **FIFTEEN** previous **Grand California** tours have seen each species. If there are two numbers separated by a comma, the first number represents trips on which it was seen and the second number the times when the species was only heard. This column is designed to give you a realistic idea of your chances of seeing each bird as we visit the incredibly beautiful, diverse and species-rich ecosystems.

Column II shows the species seen (x) or only heard (h) on the 2007 tour. This was an incredibly dry year, making many of the normally abundant species difficult to find and some species completely absent from locations where we normally find them. Check the second to last page for selected photos from this year and the last page for their identification.

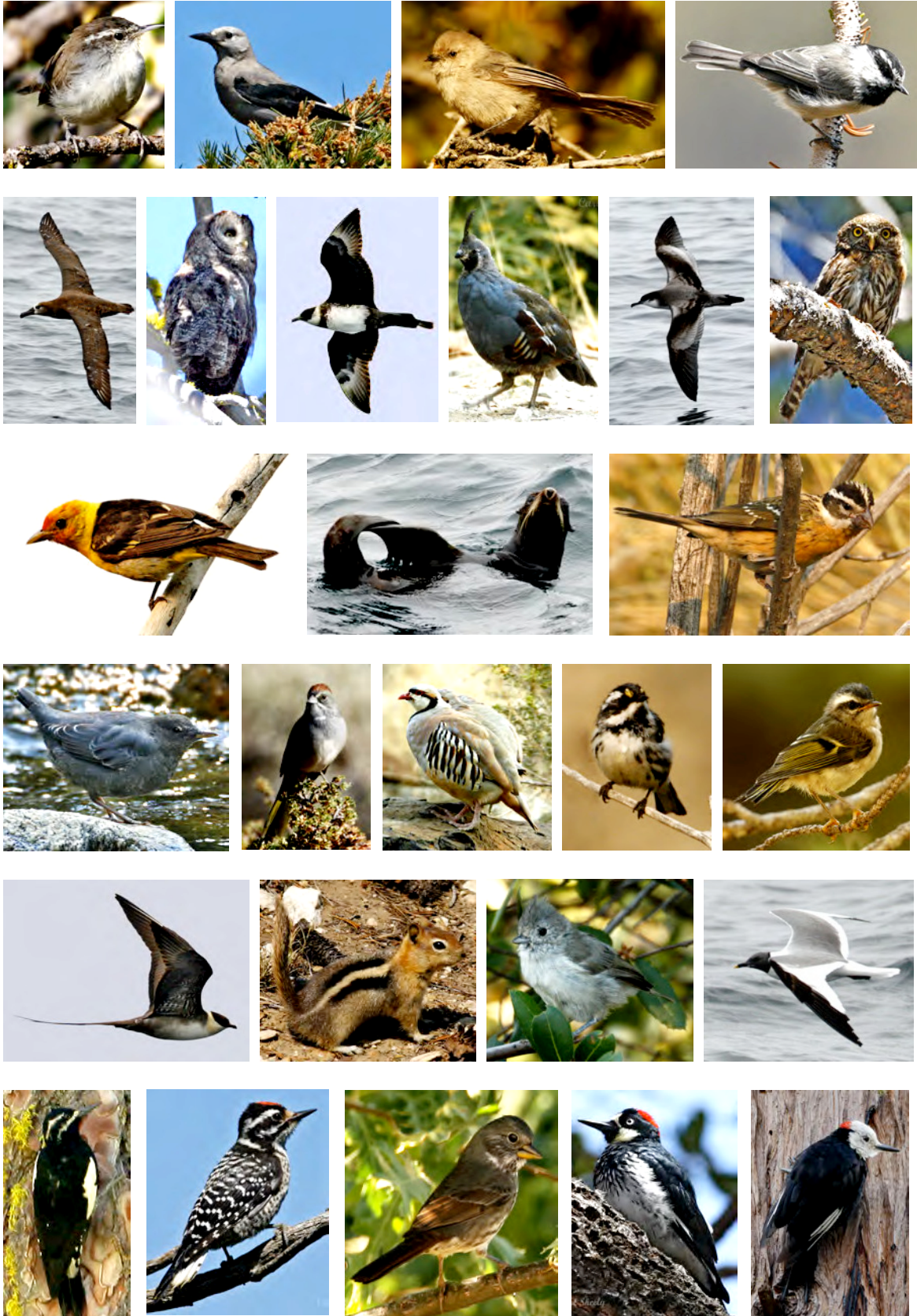
